



Mendota 48" Assembly:

Tools Required:

Drill with Quad Head Bit 1/2" Open End Wrench 1/2" Socket and Ratchet Mallet




1) Assemble main frame together as shown on one side in Detail A, *making* sure to leave hardware loose, using:


5/16" x 3 ½" Carriage bolts 5/16" Lock Washers 5/16" Hex Nuts

*Note: Set up the chair on a flat surface, this will make installation of hardware much simpler.


*Note: Set the heads of the carriage bolts into the HDPE lumber with the mallet before tightening; do not over tighten the hex nuts.




- 3) Tighten all hardware from step 1
- 4) As shown in Detail C, attach seat back to seat bottom (please use existing holes) using:
 - 2 1 1/2" Quad Head Screws



5) Attach the seat back as shown in Detail D making sure to screw into existing holes, using:



7) For 60" Mendota Slide Base Support in as shown;



8) Attach wheels as shown using;

- 2 BOLT CB 5/16"-18x3 1/2" TYPE 316
- 4 FLAT WASHER 5/16"
- 2 5/16" NYLOCK NUT
